Indian Grass
Sorghastrum nutans
Tall clump of grass with
beautiful seed head
Height: 2.5-8'
Blooms: Aug-Sept
Light: Full sun
Soil: Dry-Moist



Anise Hyssop
Agastache foeniculum
Fragrant flower spikes
attract hummingbirds
and many pollinators,
esp. bumblebees.
Height: 2-4'
Blooms: Jul-Aug
Light: Sun-Shade
Soil: Moist



White Wood Aster Eurybia divericatus White flowers with rose centers; can form ground cover Height: 0.5-3' Blooms: Jul-Oct Light: Part sun -Shade Soil: Dry-Moist



Blazing Star Liatris spicata Spikes provide nectar for hummingbirds, bees and butterflies. Height: 1-6.5 Blooms: Jul-Aug Light: Sun-Part Sun Soil: Dry-Moist



Cutleaf Coneflower Rudbeckia laciniata Tall. Very attractive to goldfinches. Height: 3-10' Blooms: July-Sept Light: Sun-Part Sun Soil: Moist-Wet



Bluestem Goldenrod Solidago caesia Stems bluish or purplish; rich woods. Height: 1-3.5 Blooms: Aug-Oct Light: Sun-Shade Soil: Dry-Moist



Coral Honeysuckle
Lonicera sempervirens
Semi-evergreen vine,
flowers until frost. Red
Berries.
Spread: 6-12'
Blooms: Apr-Oct
Light: Sun-Part Sun
Soil: Dry-Moist



Black Chokeberry
Aronia melanocarpa
Provides late winter food for birds; twiggy growth provides cover.
Height: 5-6 Spread: 3-5 Blooms: Apr-May
Light: Sun-Part Sun
Soil: Dry-Moist-Wet



Silky Dogwood
Cornus amomum
Hardy. Abundant fruit
important for migrating
songbirds. Dense stems
provide cover.
Height: 6-10 Spread 6-9
Blooms: Jun-Jul
Light: Sun-Shade
Soil: Moist-Wet



American Black
Elderberry
Sambucus canadensis
Berries eaten by 48
species of birds. Twiggy
habit provides cover.
Tolerates heavy clay.
Height: 5-8 Spread 5-8
Blooms: Jun-Jul
Light: Sun-Shade
Soil: Dry-Moist-Wet



Winterberry
Ilex verticillata
Abundant berries provide
winter bird food. Need male
and female. Cultivar OK
Height: 6-10' Spread: 4-5'
Bloom: Jun-Jul
Light: Sun-Shade
Soil: Moist-Wet



Sweet Birch
Betula lenta
Prefers moist sites but
tolerates dry; colonizes
open or disturbed areas.
Height: 50-75' Spread
35-50'
Bloom: Apr-May
Light: Sun-Part Sun
Soil: Dry-Moist
