Tour Details

Typically 60–90 minutes. We suggest 10–15 guests to encourage good discussion plus up to 4 HGCNY planning members, but you decide the final cap.

Information We Need

- **Property Description** – Short write-up for the listing
- **Scheduling** – Pick any date/time that works for you
- **Amenities** – 1–2 chairs for guests who may need to rest
- **Cautions** – Note hazards, off-limits areas, pets, or parking

Tour Goals

Tours are fun but purposeful: helping others create living landscapes that support biodiversity. Think about how your yard reflects Wild Ones mission—native plants, natural design, and earth-friendly practices. No lecture needed. Just consider a few questions:

- How has your landscape evolved?
- What worked or failed?
- Where do you see your yard in five years?
- What were your biggest challenges, and how did you solve them?
- What delights have you noticed as your yard comes alive?

Guests may ask about your plants - brushing up on their names (especially the scientific ones!) can be a fun way to prepare. Bring any landscaping dilemmas to the “Help Me” portion—great ideas always emerge.
